Purpose

- » Who is employed in the profession or who is an owner operator.

Benefits

The scholarship will be awarded to an individual and will take the form of payment of Conference Registration 2026 including the conference gala dinner and clinical workshops and up to \$1,000 towards travel and accommodation. All other costs including necessary leave to attend the Conference, change of flights etc. must be met by the applicant. The successful applicant is required to:

- » Present their Case Study (20-min presentation) on Saturday and Sunday at the National Conference 2026;
- » Provide a summary of their conference and presentation experience to be published in the Massage & Myotherapy Journal;
- » Be interviewed on Massage & Myotherapy Connect.





Application and Selection Process

The eligibility and selection criteria must be completed for the application to be valid. The application must be received in typed format, adhere to case study guidelines and be presented in the same structure as the criteria on the following page.

- » Applications will be accepted in soft copy (electronically) or hard copy and must not be handwritten;
- » Applications must have a copy of the applicants professional curriculum vitae attached;
- » Applications must include a coversheet;
- » Applications must maintain appropriate client consent to write and present a case study;
- » Applications received after the closing date and time will not be considered.

Non-adherence to any part of the application process will result in a 10% reduction on the overall score achieved or complete disqualification.

The successful applicant will be notified in writing at least three (3) weeks prior to the event.
